

The Situation:

The State of Washington has contracted with a private, for-profit company to move Sexually Violent Predators (SVPs) from McNeil Island to a residential neighborhood; near innocent children and families.

What is a Sexually Violent Predator?

Sexually Violent Predators are civilly committed sex offenders deemed to still be sexually violent, most likely to reoffend, and unamenable to existing mental health treatment modalities.

What is WSPS?

We are a grassroots community volunteer organization dedicated to stopping the government from using our tax dollars to warehouse sexually violent predators in residential neighborhoods.

What is the "Poulsbo House"?

Located at 17373 Viking Way, the "Poulsbo House" is a privately owned, for-profit facility designed to house multiple SVPs. It is in a residential neighborhood, within sight of a school bus stop, and adjoining property where minors congregate

Wasn't the neighborhood informed?

This facility was not defined as a Secure Commitment Treatment Facility. Therefore, laws regarding public notification were circumvented. Additionally, the Sheriff's Office admitted to having "issues" with service of Sex Offender Bulletins.

Are these Level III SVPs allowed out?

Yes. People deemed by the state to be too dangerous to rejoin society will be joining you in your local coffee shop or grocery store.

Can this happen to my neighborhood?

Yes. We were not informed. The county and local governments were not informed.

A Dangerous Gamble:

The McNeil Island Secure Commitment Facility (SCC) is a State-run facility designed to contain Sexually Violent Predators (SVPs) who have been civilly committed by a Court. Sexually violent predators generally have personality disorders and/or mental abnormalities which render them unamenable to existing treatment modalities. Those conditions cause them to be more likely to engage in sexually violent behavior and increase their likelihood of engaging in repeat acts of predatory violence.

The Washington Department of Social and Health Services has contracted with Westsound Support Services, a for profit company, to operate a facility that houses sexually violent predators. WSS is to provide all supervision within the residence and while escorting the SVPs into the community, including local businesses and parks. WSS operates this facility in a residential zone, within sight and only yards away from a school bus stop, and adjoining property where a minor child is known to reside

The SVPs housed by WSS are considered too dangerous to rejoin society, but will be allowed, with only a single escort armed only with a cell phone, to visit numerous public places, including Target, Trader Joes, Starbucks, Malls, Parks and Trails. These escorts are unarmed, and are neither tactically trained, nor trained in methods of restraint. Collectively, these SVPs have admitted to having sexual contact with dozens of children; the escorts are only trained to call 911 in the event something should happen. A cell phone is not enough.

The risks posed to our communities by this facility are NUMEROUS, GRAVE AND IMMEDIATE. **We Say NO!**

Meet your new SVP Neighbors

These men **now live** in the Poulsbo House.

William Deaville

Convicted of child rape and child molestation. Deaville has been a repeat offender since he was 16. After his arrest he admitted to having abused over fifty boys between four and eleven years old.

Elmer Todd Gillis

Convicted of Indecent Liberties, Assault and Rape. Gillis began his predatory behavior at age 18 and later re-offended multiple times. He received multiple behavior infractions for frottage against females while institutionalized. Court records indicate that community members cannot be entirely safeguarded against this behavior if Gillis is on a community outing.

Kim Daly

Convicted of multiple counts of Indecent Liberties over a 25-year period. Daly has violated both small children and the elderly, including the admitted rape an elderly disabled man. In 2002 he reported watching three young boys who lived next door while thinking about sexually assaulting them. He also reported watching another young boy get off the school bus with immoral thoughts of abuse.

Michael Loyle

Convicted of Indecent Liberties, Assault, Child Rape and Communicating with a Minor for Immoral Purposes. Per Western State Hospital records, Loyle has admitted to having 50 sexual contacts with children. In 2008 he recanted, and admitted to having sexual contact with **only** 20-25 children. Loyle served 18 years in prison for raping a seven-year-old girl.

A FOR PROFIT company is housing these sexually violent predators in a residential neighborhood. **We Say NO!**

Washington State for Public Safety is a grassroots volunteer organization comprised of neighbors and concerned citizens who are donating their time, energy, skills and money to stop the warehousing of Level III sexually violent predators in residential neighborhoods.

Kitsap County Commissioners have adopted an interim zoning ordinance in response to the public outcry and to prevent this from happening in other residential neighborhoods, but the new ordinances will not affect the "Poulsbo House". We will not accept anything short of closing the "Poulsbo House" down **now** to avoid the extreme risk these sexually violent predators pose to our community. Westsound Support Services has appealed the commissioners' decision, and with no other option, West Sound Law Group has filed suit on WSPS's behalf.
